



EAST COAST SPEEDWAY RIDER INFORMATION

Sign and Return the enclosed documents:

- 1. Rider License Annual Membership Application with payment.
- 2. If you are under 18 please fill out the Youth/Minor application.
- 3. "I have read and Understand this Release"
- Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk and Indemnity Agreement. Read all waivers carefully before signing.
- 5. Sign the back gate signup sheet each week you wish to compete. If you forget to sign the sheet, call (585) 739-9612 by Monday at Noon prior to the next event to get on.
- 6. If you sign up for a program and cannot appear, please inform us immediately.
- 7. To check if you are on the program, check Facebook or call.

Insurance and Gate

- The Tracks do not provide Riders with Medical Insurance coverage. RACING IS DANGEROUS. Each rider is strongly encouraged to carry their own Medical Insurance coverage.
- 2. Ambulance services, (e.g. Fire Dept. Life Flight, non-contracted ambulance, etc.) are the responsibility of the injured party.
- 3. If you are injured you must report to the referee immediately.
- 4. RIDER FEES, Front gate \$15.00 back gate \$20.00 with a license (Does not include Championship events).
- 5. MECHANIC FEES, Front gate \$15.00, back gate \$ 5.00 with a license (Does not include Championship events).

Fuel

Methanol is the only fuel allowed for adult speedway bikes. No Nitro or power producing additives may be used. *Fuel and Oil is always available for sale at the track!

Pit Area

No dogs allowed!!

Maximum of TWO Mechanics allowed per rider.

Only riders and mechanics that are signed in for that night's program will be allowed in the pits. Mechanics must be 18 years of age and wear white or black pants or shorts and enclosed shoes or team uniform. The pits will be swept 1 hour prior to start time. All un-credentialed guests will be asked to leave the pit area at that time. Competitors can unload their vehicles prior to that time but then must park OUTSIDE of the pit area. Guests will be asked to go to the grandstand area. NO VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED TO COME INTO THE PITS UNTIL AFTER THE RACE PROGRAM HAS BEEN COMPLETED!! Nobody is permitted on the track after the races!!

The main gate will **NOT** Open until 2 hours prior to scheduled race time! PLEASE DO NOT COME PRIOR TO THAT OR SET UP PRIOR! The pit gates will only be open from that time until an hour before race time! So on a regular night the pit gates will be closed at 6pm!!! You will not be permitted in unless you had an emergency and called ahead. The pit gates will be closed from 6pm to the conclusion of the program. Riders meetings will take place between 6:30 and 6:45 on a regular scheduled event.

No bikes are to be started during the National Anthem!

ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING OR VAPING IN THE PITS! First offense is a warning. Second offense is a \$25.00 fine. Third offense is disqualification from that event or the next event.

No alcoholic beverages permitted in the pit area at any time.

PLEASE THROW YOUR TRASH AWAY AND DO NOT LEAVE TENTS AND ITEMS BEHIND!

Please do not hang banners on the wall without permission.

Kill Switch - You must have a working kill switch that is operated by a non-elastic string of adequate length and thickness.

Mufflers - All machines must have approved mufflers and muffler safety cables! Approved mufflers include Bills, JITCO, SCOTTS, King, Jawa, Cody, Dominator, and Power Pros. All bikes must have muffler safety cables.

Tires - Maximum of **ONE** New tire per night! Approved 3.50x19 tires, Mitas, Anlas, JTR, Kenda, may be used or 22 inch speedway tire.

Rear wheel discs are mandatory on adult Speedway machines.

Protective Equipment - Riders must wear approved racing gear, helmet, goggles, gloves and boots plus back protectors or motocross chest with back protector are **MANDATORY** for all speedway riders!!! No Speedway or ATV competitor will be allowed on the track with bare arms exposed. Elbow and Knee pads are **STRONGLY** recommended!!! All speedway riders must wear a steel shoe on their left foot. All riders must have a visible Name and Number on your back or you risk **NOT BEING SCORED AT ALL**. All First Division Speedway Riders must wear a speedway suit!
